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OPEN THE DOOR TO POMURJE

The Pomurje region is located in the northeast of Slovenia and borders Croatia, Hungary and Austria. The center of the region is Murska Sobota. River Mura demarcates the region on two sides, where on the right side live Prleki with their typical region language and on the left side are Prekmurci with their own typical region language.

The region is touristy known of the spa tourism, its rich culinary, architecture and increasingly recognizable ethnology. The historical progress allocated the region by the Pannonia Plain, which in its genes wears plenty of other identities, what is really interesting and pleasantly to know. Miško Kranjec opened the doors to Pomurje with his tales, introduced it as a world full of secrets, marshes and good people. He wrote, that the human



in this landscape by river Mura can relax, collects life energy and goes into a world full of optimism with pleasant memories.

MURSKA SOBOTA

Many archealogical diggings and the leftovers prove, that there were people living in that area even in the prehistorical and roman times, in the 13th century. They build a court on a location of today's castle, where stood the seat of the land lord Belmura. Murska Sobota was a land market in it's centuries worth of growing. The city got it's urban look at the end of the 19th century. Even today it's possible to see the secesistic area in the individual buildings on the Slovenian street. The city center is comepletely announced as a urbanistic statue with local meaning. Murska Sobota grew the most in the 20th century, due to industry. Today the city stands as an opened city: with different religions, with opened economy, trades, school systems, health trades, cultrual buildings and tourism.

GET TO KNOW THE BEUTIFUL NATURE AND RESEARCH ITS CULTURAL INHERITANCE

MONESTARY CHURCH OF SAINT NIKOLAJ

The tradition says, that the first church in Murska Sobota supposed to stay here already in 1071. Today's building was built in the 13th century. Already then it supposed to be the seat of archidiaconate here, called »Belmura«, which is the second name for Murska Sobota. It covered the Slovenian landscape, which included the upper side of Prekmurje. Today's church was built in years 1910 and 1912 by the plans of architecture Laszlo Takats in historical style. On the east it preserved the bell from the Middle Ages. The preserved fresco, which were made in years 1370 till 1390, show the connection with Gyor and

Slovakia. The church keeps a beautiful baroquely picture of Saint Nikolaj from year 1790. It's decorated with Kregar's colorful windows.

CULTURE MARKET

The culture market is located in the center of Murska Sobota, where the Region and academic library, gallery, bronze statue of Muse Erato and the local bars are. The market is an area for intergenerational socializing, where are cultural events through the whole year, and in winter time an ice rink. **REGIONAL AND ACADEMIC LIBERARY MURSKA SOBOTA**

The first liberary after the first world war was built in 1922 and was in the rooms of today's restaurant Zvezda, a former hotel Dobrai. In the year 1955 the Regional and academic liberary was made based on people's library. Regional liberary was first located in the Sobota castle, and the academic library was on Hartner mansion on Castle street. In November of 2013 the library got it's jointly work space based on the plans of the architect Iztok Zrinski on today's location. The library has a section for adults and the youth and a utillity area fort he

events. The Biblibus works in the complex with the library, which, with it's mobility, takes care of the people in Prekmurje and Porabje.

GALLERY MURSKA SOBOTA

The opening of the gallery goes into the year 1965 with the opening of the Exhibition pavilion made by the architect Franc Novak. From the year 1973 there runs a traditional event European trienal of the little plastic. The gallery gets it's new work space in 1980, in which is a display of a constant collection of paintings, statues and works of art out of paper. The



individual displays are made regularly. SOURCE: Personal archive

MUSE ERATO

The bronze statue of Muse Erato is a work of a local woman, academic sculptress and painter Irena Brunec-Tébi. It was made in year 2012 in frame of European capital of culture, when the Community Murska Sobota took part as a partner with city Maribor. The statue is made for the erotic poets of Pomurje. The Muse symbolizes the love poetry and is depicted

with zither, a swan and besides is also an owl on the skateboard and a book with a verse of a folk man, poet and writer Feri Lainšček.

HOTEL ZVEZDA

Former Hotel Dobrai is a single-story historical corner building and is located in the center of the city. The Hotel with a casino was built by Janos Dobrai in 1909. An interesting event, which marked the hotel itself, happened 29. 5. 1919, when Vilmoš Tkalec pronounced Republic Murska from the hotel balcony with the help from land folk and army and became its

president. Today in the summer months there is a restaurant with terrace under old chestnut and the center of socializing and relaxing with music artists.

TOURISM INFORMATIVE – CULINARICAL CENTER "SAVINGS BANK OF THE PREKMURJE GOODNESS"

It is located on the Slovenia street and is one of the oldest buildings in the city center. It was build based on a plan by the architect Ladislav Takač in the year 1907. the buildings are decorated with the modern decorative elements and the main motive, the bees, and the stylized rose blossoms. This building is a former Pomurje bank and a former savings bank for the south part of the Iron parish.

On the ground floor of the building stands the Institution for culture, tourism and sport. Besides the tourism information they also offer homemade products and in handmade products from the region, there for the work space was named tourism informative-cuisine center. The "Hidden courtyard" is the scene of events with different music genres.

STATUE FOR AUCTIONEERS OF SLOVENIAN ARMY



The statue is located on the Victory square. It was built on 27th December 2013 as a symbol for acknowledge and in the memory of defender's Slovenian independence in 1991.

STATUE OF VICTORY

It's dedicated to Partisans and the Soviet soldiers in their honor and victory in the second world war and is located in the center of the square of victory. It was formally presented on the 12th of August 1945. The statue is made by the plan of a Russian architect Arončik.

MARTIN LUTHER EVANGELICAL CHURCH

The Evangelical religion is the second most powerful religion in Prekmurje. Today's Martin Luther church was build in neo



gothic style in 1907–1910 by the plans from the architect Ernőj Gerey from Budapest. The interior of the church has a wooden altar and above that there is a colorful rosette with a picture of Martin Luther and paintings in a Hungarian style. The church stands parallel with the castle entrance, to which leads the Trubar alley.

CITY PARK

The English park spreads out around the Sobota castle on a surface of nine and a half hectares and is located in the very city center. 200 year old oaks, hornbeams and grow in the park in the autumn. The park is one of the most beautifully preserved castle parks in Slovenia. The Trubar alley with oaks connects the east side of the castle with the Statue of Victory and the city center. The park is completed with statues that were dedicated to the writers from Prekmurje at 20th anniversary of the incorporation of Prekmurje to Slovenia, and it's a work from Drago Tršar (1940), a statue dedicated to the fallen workers in the second world war, (1959) and a bust of the first Slovene writer Primož Trubar at the 500 year anniversary of his birth (2008) and it's the work from Feri Novak. On the city green surfaces lies a Sobota's green trail with a beginning and end point at the Regional and Academic library.

All the green surfaces in the city completes Fazanerija, which is located in the northwestern part of the city and it's a leftover from a former forest. It awards itself with a variety of hornbeams and oaks. In the time of the counts Szápáry this part was mentioned as a zoo. Today Fazanerija is a popular recreation spot for the locals. It has a forest educational path, cycling path and a trim track and informational spots with an



educational content about the ecology of the forest. The infrastructure is completed by the tennis court, football field with a stadium and a city swimming pool complex.

First mentioned in sources in year 1255 as a mansion, in which the civic center from land Belmura was. Through history the owners changed and in the 2nd half of the 14th century the owners become the family Széchy. In the 2nd half of the 16th century they build a new two-story renaissance mansion with four towers. In year 1687 they sold it to Peter Szápáry. In the 1st half of the 18th century the courtyard was walled in with arcades, the facade was newly made and both of the entrance portals were designed. The last owner of the castle with the park becomes Community Murska Sobota in 1934.

From the year 1956 there is a Regional museum Murska Sobota, which is a regional building for protecting the movable cultural heritage in the Pomurje area. The museum collections include archeological, numismatic, ethnological, artistic historical and historical collection of Prekmurje. The regular display themed "Between past and future" shows the people's life by the river Mura from prehistory till today. In the year 1999, they receive a recognition of the European museum forum for the display.

They occasionally organize displays, handwork workshops, lessons with work papers, but also they can research in the digital Pomurje literature. The castle also includes the hall for cultural events, castle chapel for civil weddings, information spot on pilgrim path St. Martin and the Youth informative and cultural club.

THEATER PARK

Theater Park, a former Kino Park, was build in 1955 and is the work from the architect Feri Novak. In the complex of the European capital of culture 2012 the architecture heritage was restored based on the idea from the arhitect Andrej Kalamar. Cultural events and festivals are happening in the modern hall. In front of the theatre there is a statue, dedicated to the national hero– Partisan Štefan Kovač.

TOURIST SIGHTSEEING IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF MURSKA SOBOTA

PARISH CHURCH OF THE LORD'S ASCENSION, BOGOJINA

It is one of the most visited churches in Prekmurje. The church of the Lord's ascension– Plečnik's church, for the locals "The white dove was build between the year 1924 and 1927 and it's a beautiful modern sacral architecture in Slovenia.. the old roman-gothic church, that stood there in the 14th century, was redesigned by a known Slovene architect Jože Plečnik. With his ideas he included regional architecture and home trade, and pottery in his plans. The interior of the church is decorated with stone columns with arches, a wooden altar, which has pottery

jugs on top of it, a sealing made out of circular oak beams and boards which hold pottery plates from the local pottery makers. On the left in front of the entrance there is a oval tower with a bell.

In the past almost every farm was occupying with the pottery activity. That the tradition would not be forgotten, the family Bojnec opened an ethnological pottery and architecture on open air – skansen. There is a regular collection of Filovci's pottery masters of the 20th century in "potters house", where pottery workshops with animation happen. In the second house "cimprači" is the autochthonous black kitchen.

TROPICAL GARDEN - OCEAN ORCHIDS, DOBROVNIK

They grew the tropical orchids in the greenhouse on a 1.4 ha area. The first Slovenian orchids were sent to the market in November 2006. Because of the big interest they start a bigger production and today yearly send about 2 mio. orchids. The offer was diversified with the tropical garden, which is a real touristic place attraction.

In the greenhouse grows about 900 exotically examples of about hundred plant species. Bananas, avocados, vanilla, papaya, mango, pineapple, ginger, carambola, coffee, pepper etc. are growing in the summer ambient. All that is completed by the flamingo plant, tropical climbing plant, meat eating plants and orchids.

TOWER VINARIUM LENDAVA

The highest tower in Slovenia was opened in Spetember 2015 and is located on a hill in the middle of the Lendava vineyards. The tower is made out of steel, it's round and 53,5 m high and has a ground floor and nine stories.

When the weather is nice the sightseeing point offers a majestic view on Slovenia, Croatia, Austria and Hungary. The inside of the tower is decorated by themed displays, in front of the tower it's taken care the lovers of the local food and wine. In the ground floor of the tower there is an informational spot, a souvenir shop, a bar, local and Pomurje of the winegrowers and a domicile of the European order of the wine knights.

BABIČ MILL, VERŽEJ

In the past the river Mura budded more than ninety floating mills, today only one is left. The only working mill in Pomrje, the Babič mill is in Veržej. The peculiarity of this mill is the wooden millhouse, that is build on four wooden beams on a hill of the river Mura and that the water wheel is secured on two floating iron boats. Today they they grind, wheat, buckwheat, millet, corn and flour. The mill is protected as a statue and is a true tourist attraction.

HEALTH RESORT RADENCI

Radenci got their fame due dr. Karl Henn, who in the year 1869 filled the first pottery bottles of water out of the thermal spring, which he named Radainer Sauerbrun. Today Radenci are known for it's world known mineral water Radenska and the Health Resort Radenska. The mineral water is used for drinking and mineral baths, which beneficially affect by hearth and vein diseases. In the health are located two installation objects Hotel Radin and Hotel Izvir with catering-tourism offer. Near the health resort there is a Health park with walking paths. The park has a neogothic chapel of St. Ana and a fountian with a statue "The three graces, which depicts three most important Radenska springs.

TASTE THE SPECIAL CUISINE

The cuisine of the Pomurje region is very diverse, like it's landscape and culture. The food here is very rich tasting and it's a reflection of simplicity of the people in Pomurje and their life habits, historical influence and natural resources. The authentic cuisine is offered by several local restaurants on traditional and public events.

INSTALLATION IN HOTEL DIANA

The city Hotel Diana is located in the center of Murska Sobota near the bus station and it's 450 m away from the train tration. The hotel offer is beautiful and includes:

- 97 modern equipment and air conditioned rooms with internet connection.
- Wellness center "Heavenly field" (a pool with thermalmineral water, world of saunas, fitness center, massages).
- Buissines rooms with the proper ICT equipment (for 550 people).
- Catering offer with traditional and international kitchen.
- Event organization (New year celebration, weddings, proms, themed events and open-air festivals).
- Optional tours (possibility of sightseeing, sport and recreation and animation) in the neighborhood and in the city
- Renting bikes.


